You have been selected for mandatory random COVID-19 testing. You are required to complete a COVID-19 molecular test with a Public Health Agency of Canada approved test provider. Completing your arrival test is an important contribution to protect Canada and monitor this contagious disease.

Please complete your mandatory test by end of day tomorrow.

How to complete the test:

- 1. Register with the test provider in the province of your point of entry, ON using this link https://www.lifelabs.com/COVIDkit/.
- 2. Schedule your test with the Public Health Agency of Canada approved test provider.
- 3. Complete the test by end of day tomorrow.

Keep your ArriveCan e-receipt number PM440K and this email until your test is complete. You may be required to present this email to the test provider for validation.

If you have not completed your test on time, you will be contacted by phone from 1-888-336-7735. It is important that you answer the phone when we try to reach you.
